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Multi-Tenancy

NovaStor DataCenter allows you to create multiple users. Depending on the task and function, you can assign individual rights and roles for every user. This way you make sure that individual departments and remote offices have access to relevant information only. In addition the user benefits from an organized GUI that shows only the enabled features and menus. One central installation allows you to maintain multiple remote offices and departments.

Concept

Organization

An organization basically is a tenant. It defines the resources a user is allowed to see and to manage. The available resources are:

- Nodes / Node Groups
- Media Pools
- Schedules
- Reports
- Backup Jobs

Role

A role defines the features a user is allowed to manage. Furthermore the role determines the information shown on the user's interface to e.g. reduce redundant and unnecessary content.

Rights that can be assigned to a role are:

The role is defined for a specific organization.

User

You can create any number of users. Every user can be assigned to one or more role. The user then has access to all rights associated to that role.

For example a user can have administrator rights for server group A, but only reporting rights for server group B.
